Due to the traffic situation, we will need 2.5 hours for domestic flight and 3.5 hours for the international one.



CANCELLATION POLICY

1. **Definitions**

- Final itinerary: The final program after meeting the customer's requirements and agreeing on the program, services, and prices. The customer pays the deposit (and the company creates a booking code).
- Travel date: The day a customer starts the tour with the company.
- Policy application milestones: start date, 15 days before the start date, 7 days before the start date.

2. Policy on full itinerary cancellation

- Cancellation 15 days before the start date: No charge for cancellation and refund of deposit for tour and hotel services (not applicable to air tickets, train tickets, services that must be paid in advance to get an early bird price, and policies of hotels not following Lily's program).
- Cancellation from 7-15 days before the start date : 50% of the total cost will be charged for tour and hotel services.
- Cancellation within 7 days before the start date: 100% of the total cost will be charged for tour and hotel services.
- If hotel and cruise changes due to their own reasons (maintenance, rooms fixed, etc), we will support to find another similar hotel and cruise

3. Policy on program changes from the customer's side

Changes made 15 days before the start date: If the customer needs to change the final itinerary, there will be no charge and the final itinerary will be sent to the customer again (not applicable to flight tickets, train tickets, services that must be paid in advance to get an early bird price, and policies of hotels not following Lily's program - sales staffs are responsible to inform customers in advance when booking).

Changes made within 15 days: Lily's Travel has the right to refuse service changes or the customer will have to pay extra costs. Sales staff will report the extra cost after updating information from partners, and customers will have to bear all costs caused by these changes if any. (*The customer should review the entire program and confirm the final version before the tour*)

Changes made to the program after the start date:

Lily's Travel has the right to refuse service changes or the customer will have to pay extra costs. Sales staff will report back after updating information from partners, and customers will have to bear all costs caused by these changes if any.



Changes can be free up to 3 times, but you will be extra charged for the 4th time.

Customers are supported in changing the program, getting a refund in case of unexpected events such as natural disasters, storms, or accidents, injuries, food poisoning, etc caused by Lily's Travel or Lily's Travel partners' mistakes.

Based on the spirit of customer service, Lily Travel will provide maximum support for cancellations due to practical needs, but based on the principles outlined. In cases where Lily Travel is able to resell services that customers need to cancel; we will refund customers the amount we resold them for.

4. Refund Policy.

5. We will not take any responsibility for expired passports and visa applications if you apply the visa yourself.

VIETNAM ELECTRONIC VISA (E-VISA)

Vietnam e-visa can be applied by yourselves at <u>https://evisa.xuatnhapcanh.gov.vn/web/guest/trang-chu-ttdt</u>, or apply through our company at US\$ 40 per person.

The processing time is 7 working days, but we highly recommend you to send us all passport copies, passport photos and international flight etickets 14 days before the tour starts.

DETAILED ITINERARY

DAY 1: HA NOI ARRIVAL

Upon reaching Hanoi, complete the immigration and visa on arrival process at the airport. Meet our driver at the airport and board your transfers to reach the pre-booked hotel.

Complete the check-in procedure at the hotel and get ready to explore this capital city of Vietnam.

13:30: Get picked up at your hotel to visit the Temple of Literature, the first university of Vietnam, established in the 11th century.



15:15: Leave for Hoa Lo Prison Museum, which was originally used by the French colonists in Indochina for political prisoners and later by North Vietnam for U.S. prisoners of war during the Vietnam War. During this later period, it was known to American POWs as the "Hanoi Hilton.

16:15 -16:30: Back to hotel

DAY 2: HANOI – HALONG BAY

Have a hearty breakfast at the hotel and begin your journey to Halong Bay.

This journey will take you through the Red River Delta where you can see the everyday life of the Vietnamese Villagers.

Upon arriving at Halong, board a traditional sailing junk and get greeted by the crew members.

Discover some of the treasures disseminated across the Bay of the Descending Dragon during the afternoon: fascinating caves, pristine beaches, picturesque floating villages, and fantastic rock formations rising up out of emerald water.





After having a delicious lunch on board, spend the rest of the time at leisure, wherein you can choose to attend our chef's cooking demonstration and try your skills in the art of traditional Vietnamese cooking.

Spend the rest of the evening on the sundeck of your cruise and admire the colors of the sunset painting the sky.

Later, have your dinner accompanied by a wide selection of wines and beverages (additional cost for drinks) along with various entertainment options like - movie night, squid fishing, etc. You can also choose to enjoy your drink by sitting relaxedly surrounded by limestone rocks majestically springing out from silent waters in the night. Overnight stay on the cruise at Halong Bay.

DAY 3: HALONG BAY - HANOI - DANANG

Start your day early with sunrise and join a Tai Chi lesson on Sundeck.

Start the day enjoying some delights with a light breakfast followed by a colorful brunch.

Continue exploring Halong Bay by sailing across its 2000+ islets and visiting some of its major highlights.



After enjoying the spectacular scenery of Halong Bay on a memorable cruise, we'll return to Hanoi, where our attentive driver will transfer you to the airport for a flight to Da Nang.

Upon arrival, our skilled driver will be waiting to take you to your hotel, where you can check in and relax before embarking on a night of exploration in Da Nang.



Take advantage of your free time to discover the vibrant nightlife of this bustling coastal city, where you can indulge in delicious local cuisine, experience the energetic atmosphere of the night market, or simply soak up the breathtaking views of the city skyline.

DAY 4: BA NA HILLS

In the center of Vietnam, close to Danang, are the Ba Na Hills, a highland resort. It is renowned for its breathtaking mountain scenery, French colonial architecture, and an array of sights and entertainment choices. Panorama views of the surrounding hills and shoreline are available from Ba Na Hills, which is located at an elevation of more than 1,400 meters above sea level. One of the main attractions at Ba Na Hills is the Golden Bridge, a pedestrian bridge that spans across two mountain peaks and is held up by giant stone hands. The bridge is a popular spot for photos and offers stunning views of the surrounding scenery. Visitors can also take a cable car ride to the top of the mountain, which is one of the longest and highest cable car rides in the world.



At the top of the mountain, there are several other attractions to explore, including a French village with European-style buildings, a flower garden, an amusement park, and a wax museum (optional). There are also several restaurants and cafes serving a variety of Vietnamese and international cuisine.

Ba Na Hills is a popular day trip destination from Danang or Hoi An, and visitors can spend several hours exploring the attractions and enjoying the scenic views. It is also possible to stay overnight at one of the resorts or hotels located on the mountain.

DAY 5: MARBLE MOUNTAIN - HOI AN TOWN

15:00 - 15:30: Our tour guide and comfortable car will pick you up from your hotel.

16:15: Begin your journey by visiting the Non Nuoc carvings-stone village, known for its exquisite stone carvings. Marvel at the skill and craftsmanship of the local artisans as they shape the stone into beautiful works of art. Afterward, prepare to conquer the Marble Mountains, a cluster of limestone hills. Explore the intricate caves within the mountains and discover the ancient temples that have stood for centuries, including the revered Linh Ung and Tam Thai temples.



17:30: After bidding farewell to the Marble Mountains, we will take you to a local market to indulge in shopping for unique specialties and souvenirs. Immerse yourself in the vibrant atmosphere and browse through a variety of local products.



18:00: It's time to satisfy your appetite with a delightful dinner at a charming restaurant in Hoi An. Indulge in the flavors of the region's cuisine, savoring the delicious dishes that Hoi An is renowned for.

19:30: Embark on a leisurely walk through the enchanting Ancient Town of Hoi An, a UNESCO World Heritage site. As night falls, witness the town's magical transformation as lanterns of various colors illuminate the streets, creating a mesmerizing atmosphere. Take the opportunity to explore the shops, boutiques, and art galleries that line the quaint alleys, and immerse yourself in the timeless beauty of Hoi An.

20:00: We will drop you off at your hotel or preferred location, concluding the tour. Reflect on the memorable experiences and treasures you've collected during your time in Hoi An

DAY 6: DANANG - HO CHI MINH

Have breakfast at your hotel and then our driver will take you from the hotel to the airport for a domestic flight to Ho Chi Minh. Airport transfer 2 ways.

Upon arrival, relax and explore Ho Chi Minh in your own way.

DAY 7: CU CHI TUNNEL - MEKONG DELTA

This tour is perfect for those who are interested in the history of the Vietnam War or are looking for a day trip not too far away from Ho Chi Minh city. The tour takes you to two important tourist sites: Cu Chi Tunnels and the Mekong Delta.

Cu Chi Tunnels, known as the "iron triangle" during the Vietnam war, are a network of underground tunnels that were used as a military base for resistance to US forces during the Vietnam War. Cu Chi itself was once known as the "dead land" that was destroyed by millions of bombs. But today, the land is still alive and combines legendary historical structures with the unique culture of the Vietnamese.

Mekong delta is known as "the rice bowl" of Vietnam, due to the seemingly endless fields of rice. In this water world, you will see houses and markets floating along the river. This is a



fabulous destination for those who want to experience the humble beauty of the Mekong Delta, get closer to nature and meet the hospitable people of this region.

7:30am: Our guide picks you up at your hotel to go to Cu Chi Tunnel for one and half hours by minivan.

The peaceful rural rice paddy scenery contains ducks and water buffalos swimming in the rivers along the side of the road. You will find it hard to imagine the destruction, damage and defoliation all over the area, caused by bombing and mines, when Cu Chi was "A Free Target Zone ". The remnants you will see that Cu Chi still has her evidence to prove the fierce battle ground that took place there. Ever wonder what it feels like to fire an AK-47? Visit Cu chi tunnels, you have a chance to find out!



Afternoon: We will depart from Cu Chi to My Tho city for two hours by car. On the way to My Tho, we stop at a restaurant to have lunch.

Upon arrival to My Tho City, The boat takes you to a small canal, which is the place you totally escape from the busy town. The boat cruise in the coconut trees canal takes you to a coconut island in Ben Tre. We disembark and have a walk around the village. Stop at a local family to enjoy tropical fruit, taste honey tea, honey wine and listen to Vietnamese traditional music, performance by the villagers.

Continue walking on the village's road to the coconut candy shop, learn how to make candy, show some handicraft made by coconut trees. Take a walk through a village with two sides. There are so many kinds of fruits, flowers, trees, local houses, children in the Mekong delta. Take your time to take nice photos and enjoy nature scenery.

17:00 – 17:30 going back to Ho Chi Minh City.

19:00 Tour ends at your hotel.



DAY 8: HO CHI MINH - SIEM REAP

Upon arrival at Siem Reap Int's Airport, process immigration procedure, then get your luggage and walk straight to the Exit Gate where our representative is waiting. After self-introduction, you'll transfer to a hotel in the city (check in time is 2pm). Time to fresh-up and relax at the hotel.

Overnight in Siem Reap.

DAY 9: ANGKOR

We start very early in the morning so we can capture the iconic picture of the pre-dawn facing Angkor Wat temple. Sunrise at Angkor Wat can be a busy venue especially during the months of December, January, February and March.

After sunrise, we will explore the vast and rich of Angkor Wat temple, taking pictures at different angles, playing with light and shadows and capturing the most beautiful devatas carved in sandstone.

Next destination will be the Ta Prohm "Tomb Raider" fame. Ta Prohm has been abandoned to the elements, a reminder that while empires rise and fall, the riotous power of nature marches on, oblivious to the dramas of human history. Left as it was 'discovered' by French explorer Henri Mouhout in 1860, the tentacle-like tree roots here are slowly strangling the surviving stones, man first conquering nature to create, nature later conquering man to destroy.

Next, will be the impressive Bayon temple with its 54 towers and 216 faces overlooking the defunct city of Angkor Thom. The final stop will be at one of gate of Angkor Thom to capture sunset over the moat.

Dinner with Apsara Dance show at local restaurant.

For those travelers thirsting for cultural highlights of Cambodia, no visit to Cambodia is complete without attending at least one traditional Khmer dance performance, often referred to as 'Apsara Dance' after one of the most popular Classical dance pieces. Traditional Khmer dance better described as 'dance-drama' in that the dances are not merely dance but also meant to convey a story or message.

Overnight in Siem Reap.



DAY 10: DEPARTURE

After the meeting, we departed for **Tonle Sap Lake**. We will visit the floating village of **Kampong Phluk**, which means "Port of Tusks", located 20 km east of Siem Reap. It is a village built on stilts on the **Tonlé Sap**. The community largely depends on fishing for a living, spending Cambodia's rainy season (June-October) fishing. During the dry season (November-April), when the waters of the lake go down, many of them work in agriculture to supplement their income. The excursion will take you to explore the floating village and allow you to see how people live and trade.

Transfer to **Siem Reap airport** for departure to next destination. It's time to say goodbye, we thank you for traveling with us and warmly welcome you to come again.
